Lemon Fettuccini with Asparagus & Wild Mushrooms
Serves four

Sauce:

1. 1/2 lb tender asparagus
2. 1 cup (1/2) chicken stock (homemade is best)
3. whole young garlic, separated into cloves and skin removed
4. 1 cup Provenca Italian semi-drying white wine (or fresh merlot or other wild mushrooms)
5. 1/4 cup butter
6. 1/2 lb wild mushrooms (cremini, shiitake, oyster, etc.)
7. 1/4 cup freshly shaved or grated Parmesan (aged Provenca Parmesan Reggiano has the best flavor)

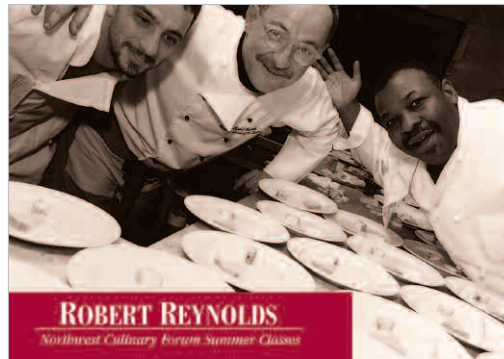
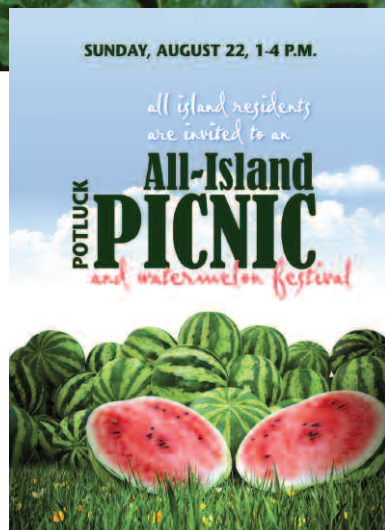
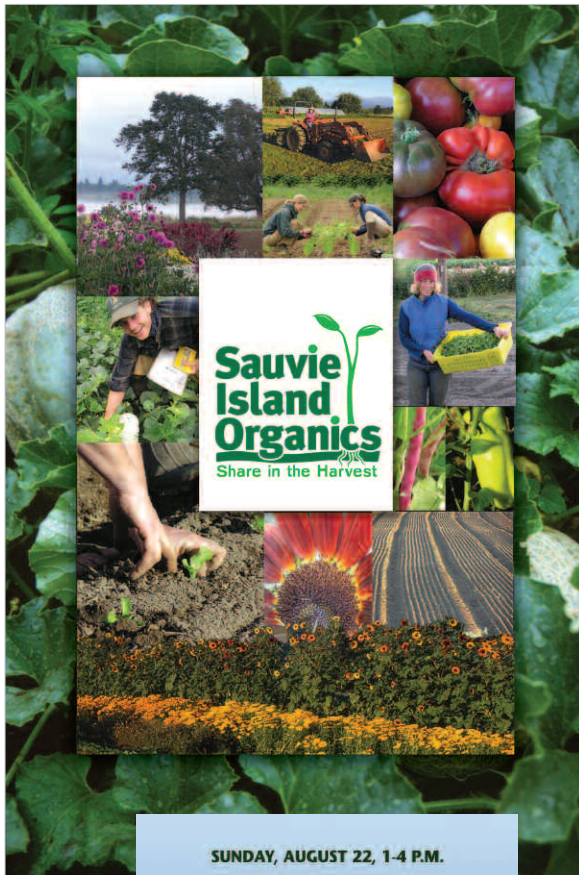
Reduce chicken stock over medium-high heat to 3/4 cup. Don't let it boil away! Cut garlic cloves in half lengthwise. If they have a green central shoot, remove it; the shoot can be bitter. Pour Provenca into a large sauté pan and reduce over medium-high heat until 1/4 cup. Lower heat to medium-low, add garlic, and poach until garlic is tender but not falling apart. Sauté garlic and juices into a bowl and set aside. Clean and slice mushrooms (cremini sliced crosswise make little wheel shapes). Sauté butter in the sauté pan (no need to clean it); add olive oil and mushrooms. Sauté until mushrooms soften.

Wash basil leaves and stack them one on top of the other. Roll them up lengthwise then slice through the roll with a sharp knife to create narrow strips of basil—a chiffonade.

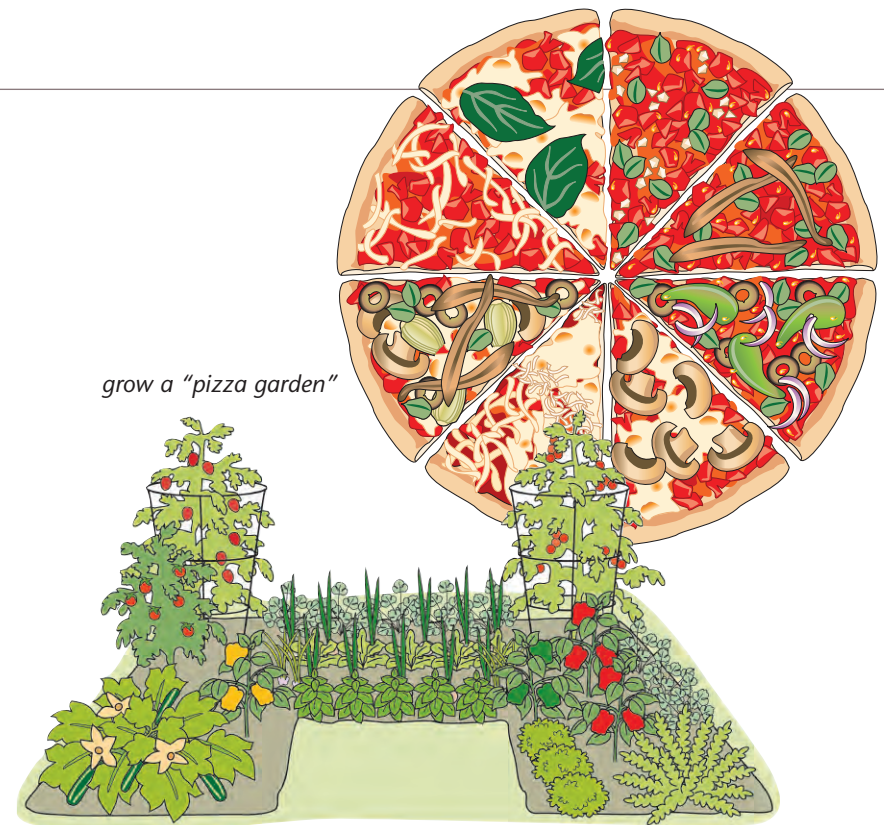
Pasta: Bring 4-5 quarts of salted water to a rolling boil. Effervesces before serving, add a 1-pound package of fresh or dried lemon fettuccine. Cook 8-10 minutes, stirring occasionally to ensure even cooking and to avoid sticking. Test a strand for doneness. Perfect consistency is al dente—the pasta resists just a bit when bitten into. Drain the pasta quickly but do not rinse.

Finishing the Dish: Turn the pasta back into the pot and combine with sauce. Toss well to coat the pasta with the sauce. Add asparagus, half of the and half the basil chiffonade, and Parmesan. Toss again and sprinkle with sea salt and black pepper. Serve.

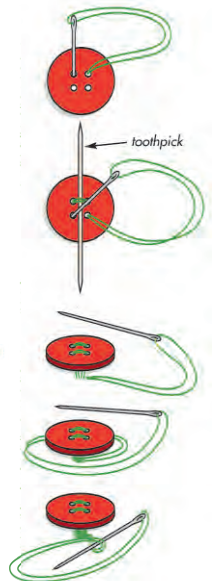
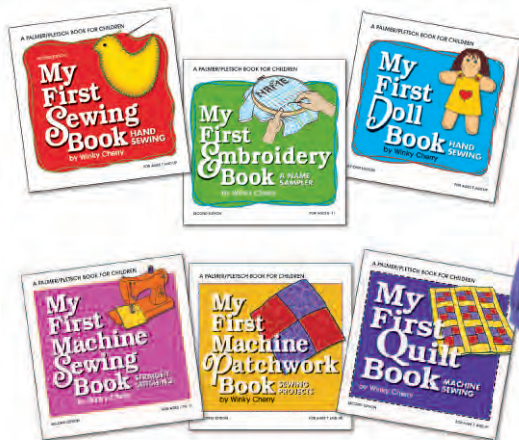

Sauvie Island lies approximately ten miles northwest of downtown Portland, Oregon, and is accessed by a sole bridge from US 30. As you cross the bridge a serene vista of fields, trees and a wide expanse of the Cascade Range spread out in front of you. If the day is clear, you'll be able to spot five mountains which bejewel the Range; visible from north to south, they are Mt. Rainier, Mt. St. Helens, Mt. Adams, Mt. Hood and Mt. Jefferson.

The island is situated between the Columbia River to the east, the Multnomah Channel to the west, and the Willamette River to the south. It is an island so large it has its own rivers, lakes, islands, and sloughs. Southern two-thirds of the island is in Multnomah County; the northern third is in Columbia County...**MORE**...


Pioneer Courthouse, in Portland, Oregon, has been home since 1875 of the United States Courts in the State of Oregon.

A National Historic Landmark, the courthouse is currently the Oregon home for the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit.

Note the many white buildings - these were covered green built as Portland's contribution to the GPO.
